LIVE YOUR DREAM AWARD

The Live Your Dream Award (formerly known as the Women's Opportunity Award) is one of the organization's major programs. This award program assists women ages 18 and older who provide the primary source of financial support for their families by giving them the resources they need to improve their education, skills, and employment prospects.

VIOLET RICHARDSON AWARD

Named after the president of the first Soroptimist club, the Violet Richardson Award honors girls who are making a difference through volunteer service. This recognition program is for young women ages 14-17 who are engaged in volunteer action within their communities or schools. Each year, this award is given to a young woman who donates her time and energy to causes that make the community and world a better place. The program begins at the local club level of the organization, with club recipients becoming eligible for additional awards at other levels of the organization.

VIRGINIA WAGNER AWARD

The Virginia Wagner Award is specific to those states in the Midwestern Region: Illinois, Indiana, Wisconsin, Kentucky, Michigan, and Ohio. Women residing in these states who are attending college/university in pursuit of a bachelors, masters, or doctoral degree are eligible to apply. This award is granted to those women who display effort toward education, have done volunteer work in the community, and demonstrate financial need. This award was established by the Soroptimist International Midwest Region in honor and memory of Virginia Wagner, a former Soroptimist club member and physician at Riley's Children Hospital in Indianapolis, IN.
